

BTMU signs cooperative agreement with Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University

Tokyo, February 8, 2013---The Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ, Ltd. (BTMU) (President: Nobuyuki Hirano) signed an agreement of mutual cooperation with Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University on February 8, 2013.
