RBI vide circular DPSS.CO.RPPD.No.309/04.07.005/2020-21 dated September 25, 2020 on 'Positive Pay System for Cheque Truncation System' has introduced Positive Pay System in Cheque Clearing process. Under Positive Pay, the issuer of cheque is expected to notify the bank key details of cheque, such as date of cheque, cheque number, name of beneficiary, amount of cheque, etc. on issuance of the instrument. This information will be cross validated when cheque is presented for clearing. <u>This change will be implemented from 1st January 2021</u>.

In accordance with the Positive Pay System, <u>on issuance of cheques above Rs. 50,000</u>, you <u>are requested to provide key details of cheque to the bank in below format</u>, failing which there would be delays in cheque processing and may potentially result in dishonor of cheques in future. Further, such cheques which are not reported in Positive Pay would not be accepted under dispute resolution mechanism at CTS grids, in case of any cheque related disputes.
