

BTMU China Opens Suzhou Branch

Tokyo, June 26, 2014 --- The Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ, Ltd. (BTMU) (President: Nobuyuki Hirano) is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary, Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ (China), Ltd. (BTMU China), opened a new branch in Suzhou and commenced operations on June 26, 2014.

Located in the eastern part of China, Suzhou, a major city in Jiangsu Province with the second highest GDP in China, is the core of the Yangtze River Delta Economic Region along with Shanghai. A large number of foreign companies including Japanese manufacturers have been operating there. There is a growing trend among companies in the service sector to expand into the region. Suzhou is expected to continue to grow in the future as a leading eastern China city.
